1. Thoroughly complete each of the four sections of the grant application.
2. Section 2 requires a Project Description. Please follow the sequence stated on the grant application for Section 2 in your summary of the proposed project. Use clear language that is relatively free of jargon that may cloud the purpose and implementation of your proposed project. Sequence the information in the project activities section of Section 2 so that project implementation takes shape for those reviewing the application.
3. Feel free to consult with students and colleagues while formulating your ideas. They can help you to see a different perspective that may influence or improve your overall project design and implementation strategy.
4. Ask for clarification if you are unsure of any of the information requested on the grant application.
5. Take a risk. w.h.a.t. will fund a variety of projects. Only you can envision and design the kinds of project and initiatives that will enrich and improve the educational experiences of the students of the HWRSD. w.h.a.t. is looking forward to funding imaginative and enriching programs that go beyond traditional or additive approaches to perhaps ultimately transforming some of our current methods for providing instruction.
